**CAUTION:** Do not inject into meat animals within 60 days of marketing. Administration of this product to well nourished animals may cause hypervitaminosis D which may result in hypercalcemia. This condition may be harmful to the animal.

**DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:** Inject intramuscularly or subcutaneously preferably in the neck area using aseptic technique.

**Calves** - 1/2 to 1 mL  
**Yearling Cattle** - 1 to 2 mL  
**Adult Cattle** - 2 to 4 mL

These suggested dosages may be repeated after 60 days, if necessary.
